# Souderton Area High School Big Red Band Boosters Monthly Meeting Minutes June 1, 2015

The May meeting minutes were read and approved as presented.

### **Executive Committee Reports:**

## **President – Marie Allen**

- **2.** We are in charge of providing ice cream and refreshments for the June 21 Concert Sundaes. It is also fireworks night so we are expecting a very large crowd and are in need of much help.
- **3.** We are in need of coordinators for the Band Store and Friday football Feasts on home football nights.
- 4. Dominoe doughraisers on July 6 & August 3
- **5.** At the May meeting we forgot to include Mike Rafter on the 2015-2016 slate as Director at Large. A motion was made to nominate Mike Rafter as Director at Large for the 2015-2016 BRBB year. The motion was seconded and there were no additional nominations from the floor. The motion passed.

### Treasurer – Georgia Myers

- 1. Presented the 2015-2016 proposed budget. New this year will be income generated from student obtained sponsorships. Each student will be asked to solicit \$150 from relatives, outside businesses, etc. These will be tax deductible. Not all the details have been worked out yet and a letter will be drafted stating the details. This additional income will eliminate the need for mini sales like car washes & pizza sales. There will continue to be three fundraisers that benefit individual Student Credit accounts: Christmas wreath, gift cards and spring flower sales. A motion was made and seconded to approve the proposed 2015-2016 budget. The motion passed.
- 2. Tara Kaufman and Eileen Solomon made a motion to spend up to \$1000 on football concession stand improvements, to be paid for out of the accumulated cash reserve. This would include one large stainless steel sink and faucet, and mats for the floors to prevent slipping when the floor is wet. The motion was seconded and approved. If we buy these items, the school maintenance personnel will install the items.
- **3.** May financials do not include totals from Duck Derby. Georgia expects to show a profit for the year.
