Expectations:

- Souderton Area High School Code of Conduct, as well as the Big Red Marching Band Code of Conduct, will be followed at all times. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - Behavior
 - Dress Code – includes swimwear
 - Public Displays of Affection
 - Drugs/Alcohol – any infraction will result in student being returned home IMMEDIATELY at student's expense
- Students are assigned rooms and will be responsible for treating them with respect. Students will sleep in their assigned room for the duration of the trip, there will be no switching of rooming assignments. If you are in someone else's room (studying, eating, playing games, etc.), you must stay in the front living area and the door and curtains must be open the entire time.
Room checks will occur every night at Lights Out. The staff/chaperone conducting room checks must see ALL students IN the room.
- Students will travel in THREES at all times. No exceptions.

What To Bring:

- Clothing :
 - Pack for all types of weather. It may be warm here when we leave, but it gets very cold on the ocean at night. Be sure to be prepared for cold weather.
 - Uniforms, costumes, accessories, shoes, etc. Please don't be the guy that forgets his uniform.
 - Two pairs of shoes. It ALWAYS rains. Always. Wet shoes are the worst.
 - Sunglasses and a hat
- Toiletries
 - WEAR SUNSCREEN. We practice outside and the sun is brutal, even when it looks cloudy.
 - Shampoo, soap, etc. is NOT provided by the hotel, bring your own.
 - Contact solution, eye drops, etc.
- Phone and charger

- Pillow/towel if desired
- Snacks
- Cash
 - Be sure to have enough cash with you for the meal on the way home. All other meals are provided.
 - We ask each student to leave a tip for the cleaning staff at the hotel, about \$5 each.
- Schoolwork
- Medications
 - Encore students must turn in all medication to Mr. Zelner BEFORE we leave. Forte students will turn theirs in to Mrs. Tink and she will turn it over to Mr. Zelner when we arrive on Thursday.
 - All medication must be in a bag with the student's name and directions for use.
 - Students are responsible for getting their medications when needed from Mr. Zelner, he will not be responsible for delivering medications to students.
