General Membership Meeting Minutes
November 6, 2017

The meeting commenced at 7:09 PM.

The minutes were approved from the 10/2/17 general assembly meeting.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

1. Scrip is available until Wednesday, 11/8/17 for Disney.

SECRETARY

1. Bill Schloo sent us a "thank you" e-mail for the gift.

TREASURER

1. Total sponsorship money received = \$10,979 (budget goal was \$8000)
2. We have also received a \$1000 anonymous donation. We will need to decide how to use this donation, as the donor would like for us to "treat" ourselves to something that is not currently in our budget, and let the donor know how it was used.
3. Final 5K race profit was \$4967. Goal was \$2000.
4. Athletic concessions profit for the year is currently \$8177, but we still need to pay the district for some expenses, so final profit is on target to meet or slightly exceed the \$7000 goal.
5. Harleysville fair check was received. We earned \$2250, which is above the \$2000 budget goal.
6. Margarita's night check was received - \$713.
7. Wreath sales totaled 601 wreaths. For comparison, we sold 402 wreaths last year. We will surpass our budget goal.
8. Disney truck – we had planned to use a Penske truck at a cost of \$1600, to be split with the school district. Bergey's truck rental has now generously agreed to let us rent a 26' truck for \$500. This cost will still be split with the district. The remaining profit from our Philadelphia Soul fundraiser can now be used to cover the \$350-\$400 in gas and tolls for the truck going to Disney, since we failed to budget for this (oops).

DIRECTOR AT LARGE REPORT

1. Frank told the general assembly that he needs someone to shadow him for next year and asked if anyone was interested to please come and see him.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT

1. Mr. Tucker thanked everyone for the season. He told the general assembly that he received the best comment from an older gentleman at the CB West game that he thought it was the most entertaining show he had ever seen.
2. Mr. Tucker received a phone call from North Penn's band director in regards to their community night on Monday 11/13/17 at 6:00 PM. The kids would treat it like a football day. They would not need their uniforms.....just their tour shirts or Souderton gear. We would need help with a truck driver and chaperones and the show would be about an hour. Mr. Tucker is going to talk to the kids and see if they are interested in doing this.
3. Mr. Tucker tried to arrange to have Chapters at Souderton but was unable to get the district to manipulate the scheduling.
4. As of right now, it is looking the indoor show will be either 3/3/18 or 3/10/18. This will be confirmed at a later date.

BAND STORE

1. The band store will be open tonight after the meeting.
2. The new garment bags are in as well.
3. The band store will be open the Friday before Disney.

FUNDRAISING COMMITTEE

1. It was decided to cancel the Walmart bake sale.
2. Julie Zettlemyer gave a rundown of the 5K. There were 178 runners and 23 for the "fun run" with 30-40 of the runners being first timers. They had 42 walk-up registrations.
3. Julie said that the 5k committee is up for any suggestions.
4. We got really good feedback and a good turnout. There were 20 races happening that day so we were fortunate to have such an awesome turnout.
5. Thank you notes and receipts will be going out to all the sponsors.
6. Scrip is still collecting gift cards for the Rafter family.
7. Restaurant Nights-We may do another Margarita's night in the spring. We had a really good turnout.
8. The Dominoes profits are a little low so try and get out there and support.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

1. The Financial Review Committee will report to the general assembly at a meeting next month.

1. Uniforms can be returned after Disney. They must be dry cleaned and raincoats washed. Make sure to have your hangers as well.
